The state of Ohio in compliance with Federal Legislation is requiring that our 11th grade students be assessed with college admissions examination. YCS D has selected the ACT to meet that requirement. The juniors attending East, Chaney, Wilson, and Choffin will be taking the ACT assessment on March 22, 2017. The examination will start between 8:30 and 9:00 am and last 3 to 4 hours. The ACT will test content in the following four areas English, Math, Reading, and Science.
